**COMMUNITY SERVICE FUND (FUND 80) SUMMARY
2013-14 SCHOOL YEAR**

In 2006, the School District of Glenwood City established a community education program in accordance with the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction's (DPI) criteria for use of community service funds. These criteria are:

- Programs are open to the general public;
- Costs associated with operating the program are funded through either user fees or a direct tax levy;
- Programs are not part of the curricular or extra-curricular program

The District's community education program has been audited annually by an external auditor for compliance with the DPI's criteria and has been deemed to meet the criteria with no audit findings regarding the use of the Community Service Fund. The program is supported entirely by a tax levy approved annually by the School Board.

Following is the community education budget for the 2013-14 school year:

Budgeted Revenue:	\$30,000
Budget Expenses:	\$35,000

Going on its eighth year, the community education program strives to promote lifelong learning to support our mission to provide the highest quality educational experience so all students can be lifelong learners, socially proficient and productive members of society. The program has grown since its inception and continues to offer ongoing and new programs to community members of all ages. A variety of class offerings and activities are offered which vary from month to month and year to year. Classes/activities are held in the afternoons and evenings during the school year and a couple of them are offered on a year-round basis.
