

Performance Stipend (Stipend):

Performance stipends are a negotiated contribution to help offset the cost of graduate courses and professional development paid either quarterly or annually

Reimbursements: Reimbursements are compensation for costs incurred by employees that are subsequently paid back to said employee after they submit an expense voucher approved by the District Administrator, then Tim Johnson



- (A) Tim Johnson submitted and received reimbursement for 6 of the 11 courses appearing on his Viterbo Transcript
- (B) Two payments were made to Tim Johnson totaling \$7,425. There are no associated receipts for these two reimbursements
- (C) Tim Johnson submitted a total of 15 expense vouchers between July 1, 2013, and June 30, 2023. All 15 expense vouchers were signed and approved by Tim Johnson



Tim Johnson - Special Education/HRA Stipend



June 9, 2015

- Memorandum issued to employees notifying them that the HRA Plan was being terminated
- •**HRA:** Health Reimbursement Account

June 15, 2015

- •Tim Johnson issued a memorandum to himself stating his eligibility for a one-time stipend for his assignment as the Special Education/Pupil Services Director
- Tim Johnson was never issued, nor held, a Special Education administrators license according to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction

July 6, 2015


•Tim Johnson submitted an expense voucher in the amount of \$44,020, of which \$38,462 was claimed to be for a "performance stipend"

August 4, 2015

•Tim Johnson provided a handwritten note explaining his payout as money accumulated in his HRA account over the last "5-7 years"

August 4, 2015

•Tim Johnson accepted a transmittal form which was presented to Hiawatha Bank, authorized by Ron Johnson, to issue a payment to himself of \$25,314 - reflective of \$38,462 less taxes





Tim Johnson - Alternative Benefits



While employed as District Administrator of GCSD, Tim Johnson received 226 payments for alternative benefits

• Listed on paystubs as "Alternative Ben", Alternative Benefits are ostensibly paid in lieu of insurance benefits that are no longer received

\$51,815 - the total amount of alternative benefits received by Tim Johnson

 Our examination of Tim Johnson's employment contracts failed to support any compensation to him for these benefits
