Question: Is there an update with criminal charges with the former GCSD employees mentioned in the Intellex Forensic Audit?

Answer: Mr. Karl Anderson, District Attorney, St. Croix County District Attorney's Office: I expect I will be able to charge it out within the next couple weeks. The previous Assistant District Attorney was close to making a charging decision but then resigned. This ADA was discussing the referral with DOJ. With the ADA's departure, Mr. Anderson is having to start from scratch on reviewing the file and possible charges.

Question: How is the GCSD moving forward from this situation?

Answer: GCSD is focused on our students and staff to provide the best educational experience we can offer. Numerous changes have been made to safeguard from these previous mistakes. While the District is still working with outside agencies as part of a larger investigation of the two former employees mentioned in the audit. We continue to create a strategic plan, update policy, create process and procedures that were previously lacking, and working diligently to ensure that the School District of Glenwood City can offer career and college readiness skills that will further our students' academic development and social conscience.
